She is Director of the UBC Master of Public Health Program and Co-Director of the Interdisciplinary Women's Reproductive Health Research Training Program at the Child and Family Research Institute in Vancouver, British Columbia. Her work with respect to family violence focuses on:

- Impact of exposure to interpersonal violence on pregnancy outcomes
- Translation of knowledge about violence from the classroom to the clinical setting
- Use of the emergency room for health promotion in relation to violence
- Designing safety interventions for women experiencing violence at home

Danielle is a psychologist with the North Island Child and Youth Mental Health Team. She will focus on:

- Infant/Child Mental Health Resources
